Southern Area Development Squad

Our third squad weekend was held on 29-30 January 2011 down at Equestrian Park. The ACTSJC is hosting the squad, which is a joint endeavor of several jump clubs in the southern districts of NSW and the ACT. Just over 30 riders attended, and to the considered for participation there are three fairly clear entry points:

- Horse and rider combinations with at least 8 points; and/or
- Horse and rider combinations already jumping 1.20m; and/or
- Riders who have competed in Championship classes at National or NSW Championships in the previous year.

The coaches at this squad weekend were Gavin Chester and Leeson Sirett, and on the two days before the squad, Leeson did a two day clinic for a number of riders who are not yet at the 1.20m level. All up a great four days.

The dates for the next squad weekend are still being settled, but it is likely to be towards the end of May.

The National Championships: Wrap-up

We have now completed all the administrative follow up to the national championships that we hosted last November. Our report to Equestrian and Australia was considered and accepted by the National Showjump Committee at our February meeting. On finances we came out positive with a \$7592 cash surplus based on a turnover of \$134,000. It's a big endeavor and it is only because of all the volunteers and our generous sponsors that we were able to come out cash positive. The club has hosted the National Championships for three consecutive years and it's now time for others to step up. This year the Championships will be held on 15 – 17 of October in Dubbo.
